

Belford Oaks Kindergarten Program

At Belford Oaks Community Childcare Centre, the Kinder Program approach to education is a structured individualised and flexible program in a Long Day Care setting.

Open-ended activities and planned goals encourage children to develop skills from their interests and enhance the development of the holistic child.

Within the Kindergarten program some of our main focuses are on:

- Social skills
- Social communication
- Fine motor
- Early literacy and numeracy
- Specialist programs such as, Italian, Music and Physical Education
- Increasing self-esteem
- General school readiness

Indoor and Outdoor Program:

In our program we run an indoor/outdoor program allowing children to make choices as to where they would like to play.

Some of our outdoor activities include: Sand pit, digging patch, swings, climbing fort and cubby house.

All activities offered indoors can also be offered outdoors- weather permitting.

Staff- One Qualified Kindergarten Teacher, One Diploma Educator and One Certificate 3 Educator

Children- 15, 3-5 years of age

Long Day Care:

Long day Kindergarten gives children the opportunity to attend kinder for a longer period of time and includes a lunch, morning and afternoon tea. Providing a Funded Kindergarten Program within a Long day care setting caters to families that need their children to attend care for full days.
